FEMOROACETBULAR IMPINGEMENT (HIP)

Surgery:

- 1.5-2.5 Hours Long
- 2-3 Incisions the size of a button shirt hole
 - Same Day Surgery

Surgical Goals:

- Repair/Clean Cartilage & Labrum
- Improve the shape of the joint
 - Decrease Pain
 - Improve Function

General Timeline After Surgery:

• 0-4 weeks Post-Op: Advance to full motion as tolerated.

- Follow crutch and weight bearing instructions given to you on the day of surgery

- On the day of surgery a range of motion and ice machine are available to help recovery
 - If you have any questions about these devices please call the number on the machine
- Start formal Physical Therapy 2 weeks after surgery date

- Find a physical therapist that's close to home and covered by insurance

- 0-3 Months Post-Op: Concentrate on activities in life that you "have" to do (errands, work, etc)
- 3 Months Post-Op: Light Sports Activities (jogging, outdoor biking, swimming, golf)
- 4-6 Months Post-Op: Return to Sports—As long as hip is comfortable—Modify activities that increase your pain or discomfort.
- Typical Post-Op Appointments: 4 weeks, 4-6 months, and 1 year out from surgery date
